CiCe: the next stages to 2011

We have at the time of going to press (early July) heard that we have passed to the final selection round for approval of CiCe4.

We have sent the Commission the Letters of Intent we have collected from all our partner institutions, and various legal documents, that have to be checked before we are finally confirmed. The new phase of CiCe, if agreed, will start on October 1st.

As soon as we have a final decision, we will send e-mails to all our partners, for CiCe3 and for CiCe4.

Assuming that we do get the final approval, the Executive are planning to open the CiCe4 activities with an Invitation Seminar to be held in Oradea, Romania, in late October. Attending will be all the new working group members. At the meeting all groups will be briefed on their tasks, and we will work out a collective work plan for the year – and for some groups, for all three years.

The plans for the 2009 Conference are also being advanced on the assumption we will be approved by the Commission.

The conference theme will be **Human Rights Education and Citizenship Education**, and the call for papers will appear in October, with on line registration and proposal facilities. The closing date for proposals will be the end of December 2008.
