Conference Evaluation

In June, the Executive Committee met in Coimbra, Portugal. We reviewed the Malmo Conference and your evaluations, taking particular note of suggestions for future development which we wish to incorporate into our next conference, 'Lifelong Learning and Active Citizenship', in Barcelona, May 2010.

We intend for the conference to be developed in the following ways:

- Workshop sessions will be timetabled in parallel with paper sessions to allow delegates to attend more than one workshop.
- We would like to incorporate a 'round table' plenary discussion (details of theme to be confirmed shortly) which would replace a keynote address.
- We also propose to include different types of sessions: for example, special-interest group discussions; opportunity to discuss research plans.
- We will continue to develop the poster session, allowing for an alternative way to present papers (which can be included in the Conference Proceedings).
- A 'Meet the Executive' session will also be included, which we feel will be particularly useful for new members/ delegates, but open to all.

There will be other changes, including some administrative processes and procedures which you will be informed about nearer the time of the conference.
