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### New CiCe Year

It was a year in which we held highly successful student and main conferences in Malmö and a CiCe regional conference hosted by the University of Patras.– thanks to all those involved both in organisation and participation. Conference Proceedings are in production and are due to be published in January.

In October 2008 we had a Working Group seminar meeting in Oradea, again thanks to those involved in its organisation. This launched productive Working Group activity, with meetings held in various European countries leading to the writing of guidance booklets which will be published in December. Two Working Groups have now come to an end: *Education for an Inclusive Europe: New Minorities*, and *Informal Education and Human Rights*. Thanks for making such valuable contributions.

The second year of CiCe4 began on 1<sup>st</sup> October: it promises to be equally stimulating and productive. A Working Group seminar is planned in November in Reims. We have two new Working Groups starting: One group will focus on Special Education and Citizenship form Strand 5 'Major issues in identity and citizenship education' with another working in Strand 7 'An inclusive Europe' . Working Groups for other strands will be working towards outputs for 2010 (see application proposal document for details) which will be available to all partners on-line and/or in hard copy.

Our annual Research Student Conference and Main Conference will be in May in Barcelona and the call for papers will be out shortly.

### Interim Report

This report must be evidence-based and we need detailed documentation that shows the time you and your colleagues have spent on CiCe activity: this is coupled with evidence of salary in order to calculate the contributions partners have made as part of the co-funding agreement of the grant.

Because these salary details need to reflect all on-costs *i.e.* to include cost to the institution beyond the salary you earn; and because we are subject to audit will require official documentation from your Human Resources department. We will send information to you shortly that explains exactly what is needed.

**Please act** on this as soon as you receive it: we stress the importance of having this information for the continued success and funding of the network.
