Dr. Roger Johansson is Professor in History within the field of didactics at Malmo University Sweden where he heads the research institute, IMH the Institute for studies in the history of Malmo. He is also Professor with a chair in Educational Sciences at Lund University.

His research has taken place in Sweden, United States of America, Greenland and England. He co-authored the history Report of the national Evaluation of the Swedish Compulsory School, 9th grade (National Board of Education). His research interests are within the field of the use and understanding of history in social conflicts focusing on citizenship, and contemporary cultural and social history. He has published a number of books over the years in this field.
