<b>Outline</b>	<p>This Working Group will establish and brand the Centre's identity, which will be housed on the CiCe website, and market its offering through promotional materials, disseminated via the CiCe Network and its activities including doctoral summer schools and research student conferences; as well as through research centres and other networks (months 1-12)</p> <p>Organise two student conferences and training workshops held immediately prior to the main Network conference. A selected group of students will present papers to a supportive but critical audience, and be offered comment and support activities from expert supervisors. Each year, the WG call for student papers/applicants in the autumn, select participants in January, and hold the conference and workshops in May. The working group scrutinise and select research student applications, selecting those most likely to benefit from the training programme. They also select which of the papers that have been presented should be published in the proceedings (Months 8, 20)</p> <p>Building from the above, a number of students will be offered the opportunity to attend (at own cost for travel and subsistence) a doctoral summer school that will provide a substantial training programme for PhD students with expert, intensive and multi-disciplinary support (2014).</p> <p>Publish on-line guidance drawn on research and research supervision will aim to enhance research and supervision capacity with particular regard to the knowledge triangle; The group will also run workshops at our Annual Network Conference designed to support Continuing Professional Development and develop excellence in practice.</p>
